

Accessing courses on MyNetball

1. Go to <http://my.netball.com.au/> in your browser
 - a. If you have trouble accessing any pages in this walk through, try again using Chrome as your browser
2. Log in to your MyNetball account with your Netball WA number in the Username box and your password in the Password box (or retrieve a lost password with the orange *Lost Password?* link below the Login boxes)



3. When you have logged in, click on the Online Learning tab



4. Once you are in the Online Learning tab, your page should have a series of green Enrol buttons next to various courses


5. If you are doing the Exam, click on the green Enrol tab in the Section I Umpire Exam box, then go to step 8 in this walk through
 - a. This Exam is free of charge
6. If you are doing the Level 1 Course, click on the green Enrol tab in the Level 1 Umpires Course box, then go to step 24 in this walk through
 - a. Please note that this Course costs \$25, and you will need to enter payment details
7. If you are doing the Foundation Coaching Course, go to step 34

Learning - Section I Umpire Exam - Product Select

The Section I Theory Examination below is part of the National Officiating Accreditation Scheme and tests the basic rules of the game.

A Section I Theory Examination pass is a prerequisite for a C Grade Badge, the introductory level umpire accreditation.

National Umpire Development Framework (NUDF) This is a comprehensive guide to umpire accreditation and umpire development within Australia and includes details of the structure of Netball Australia's Umpire Committees and Panels. It contains all the information you need to gain an umpires badge for netball, from club level right up to national level. For a copy of the full guide click here.

Section I - Umpire Exam
It is highly recommended that prior to commencing this exam you read a copy of the Official Rule Book and Exam Guide. These are available for purchase by visiting the Netball Australia website or by calling Netball Australia on 03 8621 8600.

To pass you must score at least 70%. If you score less than 70% you will need to complete the exam again to be registered as a pass with Netball Australia and your State Netball Organisation.







The official Rules of Netball are now freely available online. Click [Official Rules of Netball](#) to view the rules.

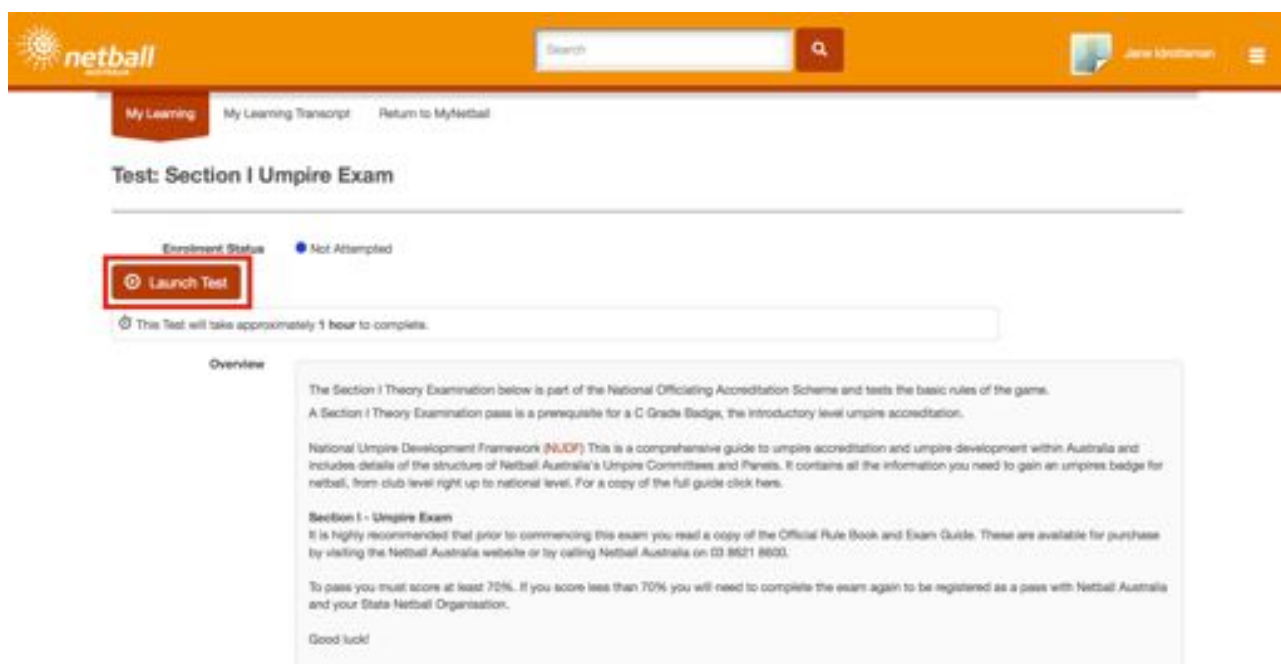
The on-line version is available in A4 size while the pocket-sized, hard copy of the official rule book still available for purchase by visiting the Netball Australia Online Shop.

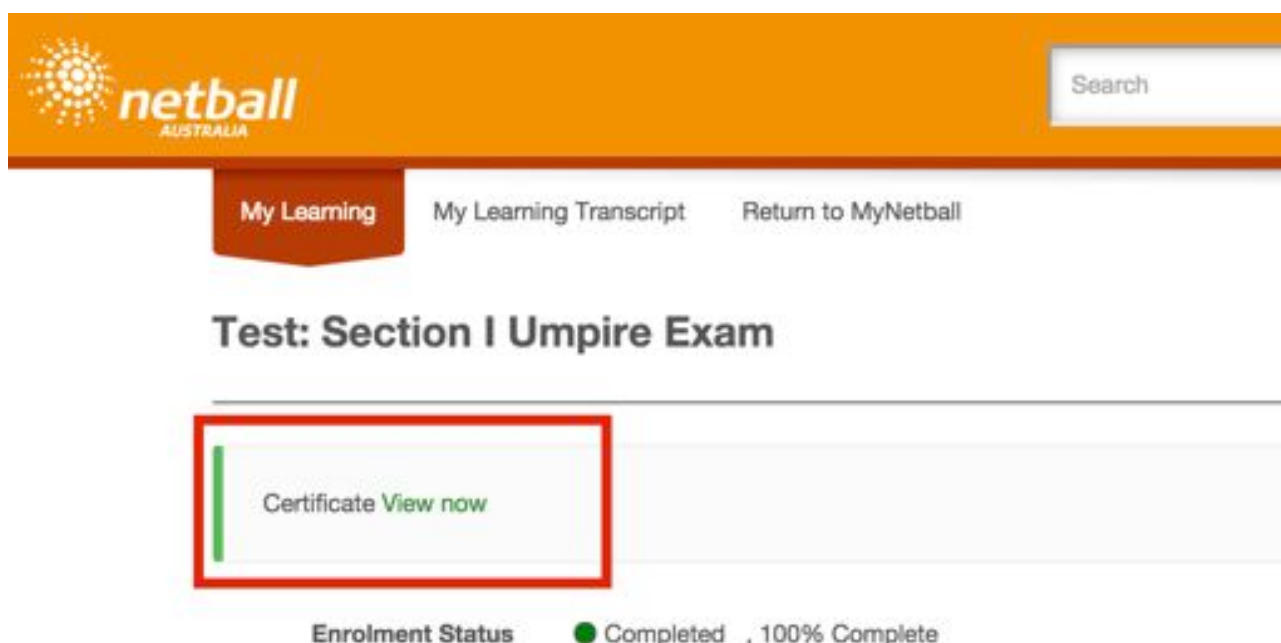
16. This will take you to a PDF copy of the rules, which you can use before and during the Exam, and is easily downloadable



17. Take the time to look at the rules before you start: when you get into the Exam, you'll notice that the questions are asked in the same sort of language style as the Rules are set out in. This might be helpful in understanding the questions
18. Go back to your Exam tab. Once you've read the instructions and you're ready to begin the Exam, click on the Launch Test button near the top left of your screen
 - a. Please note that there is a 1 hour time limit on completing the Exam



19. When you enter the Exam, you'll see that there are different sections to the test. Once you complete each section, click through to the next one to continue
20. Once you've finished the Exam, you'll get to see your results, and the answers to the questions that you were asked. Congratulations on finishing!
21. If you've finished with a score of 70% or more, you'll be able to download your certificate at the top of the page by clicking on the View Now link



22. This will open up a Save As box on your browser. Save your certificate to a safe place on your computer, so that you can keep it as a record
23. If you didn't get the 70% score, don't worry! You can try the Exam as many times as you need, and you'll definitely learn more as you do

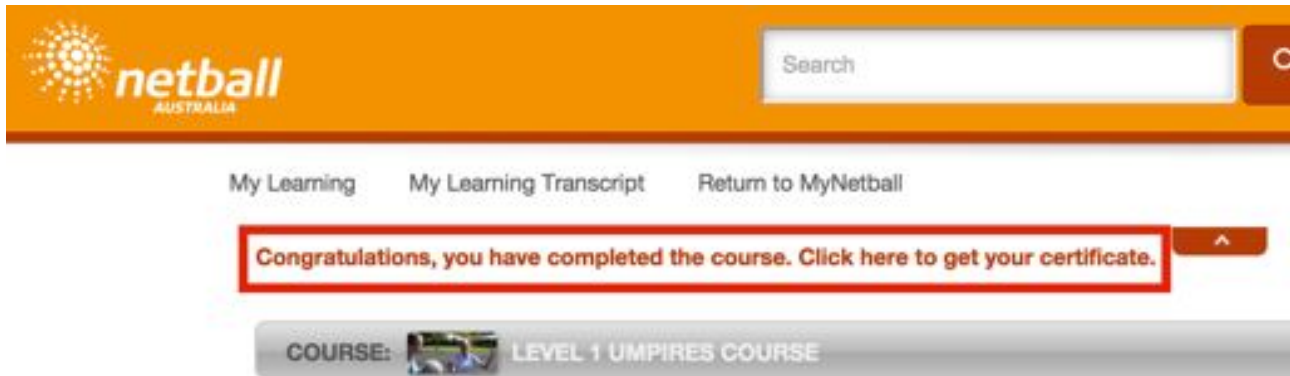


